- First Supervisorial District** (most of the High Desert communities including Adelanto, Apple Valley, Baker, Barstow, Edwards AFB, Fort Irwin, Hesperia, Lucerne Valley, Needles, Phelan, Twentynine Palms, Victorville, Wrightwood, and others)
- Fifth Supervisorial District** (includes most of San Bernardino portions of the cities of Colton, Fontana, Highland, and Rialto along with the unincorporated communities of Bloomington, El Rancho Verde, and Muscoy)

Two seats are open for appointment to unexpired terms on the San Bernardino County Committee on School District Organization representing the first and fifth Supervisorial Districts. Interviews are planned for Wednesday, February 16 beginning at 6:45 p.m. at the County Schools Office, 601 North E Street, San Bernardino. Applicants should submit this form by 4 p.m., Thursday, February 10 to the contact below.

The County Committee on School District Organization has responsibility for dealing with all school district organization matters. Organization includes altering the number of trustees, establishing trustee boundaries, school district boundary changes, and/or unification. The County Committee consists of 11 members—two from each supervisorial district and one member elected at-large. Terms of office are for four years. Terms are staggered with elections held annually in conjunction with the Fall Meeting of the County School Boards Association.

County Committee members cannot be employed by a school district in *any* county, community college district, or county superintendent, either in a classified or certificated position. Provisions in Education Code Section 4007 allows any member of the governing board of a school district or community college district to simultaneously serve as a member of the County Committee.

Monthly meetings of the County Committee normally are held on the third Wednesday at 6:45 p.m. as necessary. Meetings are conducted in accordance with the Brown Act (open meeting law). Regular meetings of the Committee are held at the San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools Office, 601 North E Street, San Bernardino.
