

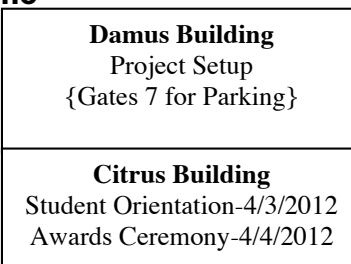
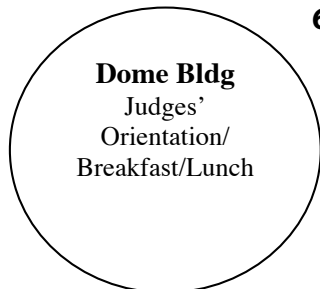

The Science Fair is open for public viewing on Wednesday, April 4, 2012, 9:00 a.m. – 7:30 p.m. There is no charge for visitation, but organized groups, including school classes, should reserve a specific time by phone (951) 826-6570. Your group's visit should be planned for 1-1.5 hours. School groups should be organized as a properly documented, district-authorized "Field Trip" and students protected by insurance provisions. All participants and buses will enter through Gates 7 or 8 off Arrowhead Avenue per agreement with the National Orange Show. Tour groups must have at least one adult for each 8 students.

Reminder: The science fair is only a two-day event. Projects are judged on Tuesday and the awards ceremonies will be held on Wednesday.

Note: Pick up all projects after your awards ceremony. Projects left in the Damus after 7:30 p.m. will be discarded by the National Orange Show.
